Introductory Issue: Various biblical motivations for obeying and serving God

- 1. To show our gratitude for His grace in saving us (2 Corinthians 5:14, 15)
- To please and glorify God (2 Corinthians 5:9)
 To cause others to be saved and glorify Him (Matthew 5:16)
- 4. To serve the needs of others in the body as God's tool (1 Peter 4:10)
- 5. To fulfill God's personal plan for our life (Ephesians 2:10)
- 6. To receive God's approval/reward in heaven and be thus accountable for serving Him on earth (see below)
- Precious Metals/Gems: God will give special recognition in Ι. heaven for our obedience on earth (1 Corinthians 3:8-15: 4:1-5).
 - A. Believers will be rewarded for the quality of their life and ministry for eternal value (1 Corinthians 3:8-15).
 - B. The measurement of reward is faithfulness and motives, not human standards (1 Corinthians 4:5).
- П. Prizes: Eternal rewards motivate us to be dedicated to God (1 Corinthians 9:23-27; 2 Corinthians 5:9,10).
 - A. The Race/The boxer: God rewards believers for dedication (1 Corinthians 9:23-27).
 - B. The Judgment Seat of Christ: God rewards believers for what has eternal value but cannot reward what doesn't.
- Cities: Eternal rewards hold us accountable for what God gave Ш. us (Luke 19:12-24).
 - A. We all have equal opportunity for rewards.
 - B. Rewards mean extra privilege of serving God in heaven.
- IV. Crowns: God will receive the glory for our eternal rewards, not us (Revelation 4:4,10).
