Gaius the Generous

3 John 1-8

- I. The significance of a good reputation (3 John 1-4)
 - A. Love: John greets Gaius by expressing his Christian love for Him (1)
 - B. <u>Prosperity</u>: John tells Gaius that He prays for his physical prosperity because he knows of his spiritual prosperity (2).
 - God controls our blessings, but we can pray for the healthy and success of someone who is growing spiritually.
 - Pray with a spiritual priority regardless of a person's physical need or desire.
 - C. <u>Joy</u>: John commends Gaius for obeying God's truth because nothing brings him greater joy (3-4).
 - We will be most committed to that which brings us the most joy.
- II. The value of a generous heart (3 John 5-8)
 - A. John commends Gaius' hospitality and generosity of traveling ministers (5-6)
 - 1. Hospitality means reaching out beyond those we already know (5).
 - 2. Hospitality means sacrificing personal convenience and financial resources (6).
 - B. John explains how hospitality and generosity makes us partners with God (7-8).
 - 1. We are serving God when we help those who serve God (7).
 - 2. We are actual partners in every ministry we support (8).
