## Costs and Rewards of Following Christ Mark 10:28-31

- The Costs of Discipleship: Peter asks how Jesus will reward their sacrifice (Mark 10:28).
  - A. <u>Leaving all</u> To let go of anything that is more important to us than our relationship to Jesus Christ.
  - B. <u>Following Christ</u> To pursue the life-long goal of closeness with Christ and service for Christ.
- II. <u>The Rewards of Discipleship</u>: Jesus tells the disciples to trust him with the rewards of following Him (Mark 10:29-31).
  - A. Areas of Sacrifice (10:29a).
    - 1. Living without typical family fellowship or approval
    - 2. Living without financial security
  - B. Motives of sacrifice (10:29b)
    - 1. For Christ Motivated by love for Christ
    - 2. For the Gospel Motivated by love of people
  - C. Areas of Reward (10:30)
    - Other <u>family</u> in this life New meaningful relationships with other people as we follow Christ
    - 2. Unexpected material blessings in this life as we follow Christ
    - 3. Persecutions The privilege of enduring with Christ!
    - 4. Eternal life in <a href="heaven">heaven</a> Don't forget the obvious! Stay focused on heaven!
  - D. The Irony of Sacrifice and Eternal Rewards (10:31)
    - ✓ God's eternal rewards in heaven will reveal many surprises about who really "won" on earth.
