How to have Fellowship with God (Part 1) 1 John 1:5-7

- I. <u>Our Problem Sin</u>: Closeness with God is difficult for believers because God is holy and because we don't admit or even know our own sin (1 John 1:5,6).
 - A. <u>Light God's Perfect Standard</u>: We are seeking a close relationship with One who is absolutely perfect (1:5).
 - B. <u>Walking in Darkness Our Sin</u>: We may claim or think we have fellowship with God when we are actually *hiding* sin or are *self-deceived* about our sin. (1:6).
- II. <u>The Solution Walking in the Light</u>: Closeness with God is possible if we expose our sin to God and rest in the continual cleansing of Christ (1 John 1:7).
 - A. <u>Walking in the Light</u>: The key to fellowship with God is to continually and honestly expose our thoughts and motives before God (1:7a).
 - B. <u>The Blood of Christ</u>: We can enjoy fellowship with God not because our sin is insignificant, but because of the continual effect of God's grace through the cross of Christ (1:7b).
