With a Willing Heart  
Funding the Tabernacle – Exodus 35-40  
Part 2 – Multiply

- I. Giving with a heart that pleases God
  - A. A thankful worshipping heart – Gifts to build the tabernacle were to come from what He had given them.
    - God provided the wealth they were to give (Exodus 3:21-22; 12:35-35).
    - Giving back to God is worship (Exodus 35:4,5, 21, 22, 24, 29).
  - B. A willing sacrificial heart – The people sacrificed with a willing heart, not compelled or pressured.
    - God worked in their hearts to give willingly what they could have kept (Exodus 25:2; 35:21, 26, 29)
    - Before we have a willing heart, we must encounter God with a repentant heart (Exodus 32-34).
    - Men and women sacrificed together (Exodus 35:5-29).
- II. Providing a place to be used by God
  - A. Giving with the willing heart brought such abundance, Moses asked people to stop giving (Exodus 3:1-7).
  - B. Giving with the willing heart resulted in the tabernacle where God was glorified (Exodus 40:33-38).
