Relating to God through Giving

Part 3 – Biblical Financial Stewardship

I. Three Widows who Believed God about Giving

- A. The Widow and Elijah (860 BC 1 Kings 17:7-16)
 - 1. She had serious financial needs herself.
 - 2. She was a gentile believer in the true God.
 - 3. She was asked for a big percentage of the little she had.
 - 4. She heard God's promise to provide if she gave.
 - 5. She believed God and first gave obediently to Him.
 - 6. God provided for her needs miraculously.
- B. The Widow and Jesus (30 AD Luke 21:1-4)
 - 1. She gave as worship.
 - 2. She was not too poor to give.
 - 3. Jesus evaluated the sacrifice of her gift, not the amount.
 - 4. Her giving revealed that she trusted God for the future.
- C. The Widow and God's business (1990's)

II. Giving connects us relationally with God.

- A. Giving is about **Stewardship**.
 - (Deuteronomy 26:10) "And now I bring the firstfruits of the soil that you, O LORD, have given me." Place the basket before the LORD your God and bow down before him."
- B. Giving is about Worship.
 - Proverbs 3:9) "Honor the LORD with your wealth, with the firstfruits of all your crops;"
- C. Giving is about <u>Trusting God</u>.
 - (Malachi 3:10) "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. <u>Test me in this</u>," says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven..."
