Giving with a grateful heart

1 Chronicles 29:10-21

Part 4 - Multiply

- I. Psalm: Praise be to You – David praised God for his greatness (29:10-13).
 - A. God is praised for BEING GREAT (10-11).
 - He is infinite in time – eternal.
 - He is infinite in power.
 - He is infinite in glory.
 - He owns all things.
 - He has authority over all things.
 - B. God is praised for SHARING HIS GREATNESS (12-13).
 - All wealth, honor and power comes from God (12).
 - So we must thank and praise him (13).
- II. Reflection: Who am I? – David was in awe at the privilege of giving (29:14-19).
 - A. My gratitude matters – God, it's amazing how generously we can give and You value our gifts (14-16).
 - I'm just temporary here on earth.
 - I'm only giving what You gave to me.
 - What I give is all Yours anyhow.
 - B. My motives matter – God, you are testing my heart (17-18).
 - Worship giving is sincere, willing and joyful.
 - C. My legacy matters – God, continue my motives in all who follow me – especially Solomon (19).
- III. Worship: Sincere giving creates praise, not pride (20-21).
 - A. David led them in worship and sacrifice.
