Giving Promises and Giving Plans

Part 5 – Biblical Financial Stewardship

I. God's Promises for our Giving

- A. Examples of Blessings for Givers (Old Testament)
 - 1. <u>Giving</u>: The Shunammite woman was given a son, her son's resurrection, and her land and income (2 Kings 4:8-37; 8:1-6).
 - 2. <u>Tithing</u>: Under the Old Testament covenant, God gave material blessings for those who tithed faithfully (Malachi 3:10).
- B. Promises of Blessings for Givers (New Testament)
 - ➤ General Principle: God blesses givers (Luke 6:35-38).
 - > General Principle: God blesses givers (2 Corinthians 9:6).
 - 1. We will have enough to live on (2 Corinthians 9:8).
 - 2. Our ministry will multiply (2 Corinthians 9:8,11).
 - 3. We will have enough to give even more (2 Corinthians 9:10-11).
 - 4. People will thank God their need was met (2 Corinthians 9:12).
 - 5. People will praise God for our generosity (2 Corinthians 9:13).
 - 6. People will pray for us (2 Corinthians 9:14).
 - 7. Eternal rewards credited to our account (Philippians 4:17-19)
 - 8. We have the privilege of pleasing God (Philippians 4:18).
 - 9. All our needs, including money, will be met (Philippians 4:19).

II. God's Plan for our Giving

- A. Give Proportionately
 - As God has prospered (1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Cor. 8:11-12)
- B. Give Consistently according to a plan
 - Regularly 1st day of the week (1 Corinthians 16:2)
- C. Give personally, willingly and cheerfully (2 Corinthians 9:7).

Giving Issues to Decide

- 1. Forms of giving (In addition to % of income 1 Corinthians 16:2)
 - o Giving items needed by people or ministry (Exodus 35:22-29)
 - Selling items of value, stocks, estate giving (Acts 4:34-37)
- 2. Who to give to (In addition to the Local Church)
 - Missionaries and ministry organizations
 - Personal needs we know of
