## Omnipresence: God is with you

Psalm 139:7-12

## I. Omnipresence: God is everywhere.

- A. God is infinite in relation to space.
  - God is spirit and not limited by space (John 4:24).
  - God is everywhere, but separate from His creation (not pantheism).
  - God is present whether we acknowledge him or not (Genesis 28:15-16).
- B. God can localize his presence as He chooses.
  - In Heaven (Matthew 6:9; Hebrews 1:3)
  - In appearance as a man (Genesis 18)
  - In the incarnation of Jesus Christ (John 1:14)
  - In the tabernacle/temple (Exodus 25:8)
  - In the church Christ's "body" (Ephesians 2:22)
  - In individual believers (Romans 8:9-11)

## II. God is always with me (Psalm 139:7-12).

- A. I cannot escape God's presence (139:7).
  - His presence holds us accountable.
    - 1. He sees all my sin (Psalm 90:8; Proverbs 15:3; Hebrews 4:13).
    - 2. He sees all my motives good and bad (Job 31:4-14; 1 Corinthians 4:5)
- B. God is everywhere I could ever be (139:8-10).
- C. God is equally in the dark as in the light (139:11-12).
  - His presence encourages and assures us.
    - 1. He's with us when we are afraid or lonely (Psalm 118:6-7)
    - 2. He's with us as we obey him in spite of our fears (Joshua 1:7-9; Jeremiah 1:5-8).
    - 3. He is with us as we share the gospel and make disciples (Matthew 28:20).
