SERMON OUTLINE

Omnipotence: God made you...very special

Psalm 139:13-18

- I. Omnipotence: God is infinitely powerful.
 - A. God's power is Infinite (Job 9:4-12; 26:7-14; Isaiah 40:22-26).
 - God's power is beyond understanding (Job 26:36).
 - God's power never contradicts His character (holy, logical), but may contradict nature (miracles).
 - God's omnipotence proves there is none like Him (Exodus 9:14; Psalm 86:8; Jeremiah 10:6).
 - B. God's omnipotence is displayed by His <u>Creation</u>.
 - He created all things out of nothing (ex nihilo Genesis 1:1; Psalm 33:6; Hebrews 11:3).
 - Creation displays God's omnipotence and character to all (Psalm 19:1; Romans 1:18-20; Acts 17:24-28).
 - C. God's omnipotence establishes His Supremacy.
 - God's power always accomplishes his plan (Job 42:2; Psalm 115:3; 135:5-6; 2 Chronicles 20:6; Daniel 4:34-35; Revelation 20-22).
 - D. God's omnipotence is the basis of our <u>Worship</u> (Matthew 6:13[KJV]; Revelation 4:11; 5:13-14).
- II. God powerfully created me exactly as I am (Psalm 139:13-18).
 - A. Beginning of life: God made me in the womb exactly as I am (139:13-16a).
 - God formed me emotionally and physically as I am (13).
 - God deserves my praise for the extraordinary way He made me (14).
 - God watched over me from conception on (15-16a).
 - B. End of Life: God ordained the details and length of my life (139:16b).
 - C. <u>Throughout Life</u>: God has countless good and realistic intentions for my life as He enables me (139:17-18).
