## Jesus: Rejected or Received?

John 1:10-13

- I. Jesus, the Creator came to the world, but the world rejected Him (John 1:10).
  - > Reasons why Christ is rejected
    - o The world pursues **sin** instead of the knowledge of Christ (Romans 1:18-20).
    - o The gospel seems **foolish** (1 Corinthians 1: 18-23; 2:13-15).
    - o People are **blinded** (distracted/fooled) by Satan (2 Corinthians 4:4; 11:13-14).
- II. Jesus, the Messiah came to the Jews, but the Jews rejected Him (John 1:11).
  - > Examples of Rejection
    - o Herod
    - o Pharisees
    - Enemies of the early church
- III. All who "received" Jesus as God and believed in Him became children of God (John 1:12-13).
  - A. The Choice we must make To *believe* in Christ (12a).
    - Those who "receive" Christ are those who believe in Christ alone for eternal life (John 3:14-16; 36).
  - B. The Result of the Choice We become *children of God* (12b).
    - We join God's family by spiritual birth, not physical (John 3:3-8).
