Imitating the Attitude of Jesus Christ Philippians 2:1-11

- I. The Christian problem of selfish pride (The letter to the Philippians)
 - <u>Main Issue</u>: Will we choose selfishness and pride or the attitude of Jesus Christ when he came to earth (Philippians 2:3-5)?
 - A. *Selfish Ambition/vain conceit* I want to be admired for ministry instead of those who are now admired (Philippians 1:12-18)
 - B. *Looking out for our own interests* How something affects me is more important than how it affects you (Philippians 2:19-22).
 - C. *Considering ourselves better* My way of serving Christ is better than your way (Philippians 4:2-3).
- II. The solution to our selfish pride is to imitate the servant attitude of Christ (Philippians 2:6-11)
 - A. Jesus Christ's unthinkable step of humility The Incarnation (2:6-7)
 - B. Jesus Christ's unswerving commitment to the need of others The cross (2:8).
 - C. Jesus Christ's eternal reward He is exalted over all to the glory of the Father (2:9-11).
 - Our true identity: Servants of Jesus Christ
