## Jesus is the answer to our real needs Isaiah's Christmas prophecies

## I. <u>Immanuel</u>: God is with us as we <u>fear</u> the future (Isaiah 7:4-17; 8:11-17).

- A. <u>Immediate fulfillment</u> of Isaiah's prophecy in <u>700 BC</u> A child would be born naturally, but before he was about 12, God would deliver Judah from their enemies.
- B. <u>Far future fulfillment of Isaiah's prophecy Jesus was born supernaturally of a virgin to deliver us from our sins (Matthew 1:20-23).</u>
  > Immanuel = "God with us"
- C. <u>Application</u>: Fear is being convinced of a bad outcome. Trust is believing that God will bring a good outcome to those who love Him (Romans 8:28).
  - > Fear leads us to take control using human means (2 Kings 16:7-9)
  - > Trust means yielding control and obeying God.

## II. <u>A Son is Given</u>: God gives hope as we have <u>regrets and hurts</u> (Isaiah 9:1-2; 6-7).

- A. Israel was judged severely (Assyrians 722 BC), yet Jesus would one day come to them bringing spiritual light (Isaiah 9:1-2; Matthew 4:13-17; Luke 1:76-79).
- B. Jesus would come as a baby not for people who have it all together, but for us with our real hurts and spiritual needs (Isaiah 9:6).
