Getting Just What We Needed at Christmas

Hebrews 2:9-18

- I. Jesus the Son of God became Man so He could die for our sins (2:9).
 - A. Jesus who is greater than angels was made lower than angels by becoming human (9a).
 - B. Now Jesus is greater than all because he died sacrificially for the sins of all (9b).

- II. Jesus became our Captain so He could lead us from suffering to glory (2: 10).
 - A. God wants us to experience His eternal glory (10a).
 - B. As our Captain, Jesus led us to salvation through suffering on the cross (10b).

- III. Jesus became Family so He could deal with our deepest needs (2:11-15).
 - A. We are His brothers – We can now qualify as Holy and belong to God’s family (11).
 - B. We are His children – He assures us we can trust God’s promise of salvation (12-13).
 - C. We are finally free – Jesus freed us from Satan’s power and the fear of death (14-15).

- IV. Jesus became our High Priest so He could solve all of our sin problems (2:16-18).
 - A. His death satisfied God’s justice so we could be saved from the penalty of sin (16-17; John 3:16).
 - B. His victory over temptation proves He can give us power over our temptations (18; Hebrews 4:14-16).
