1. When the fullness of the time came

At just the right time Jesus became a man.

It was all according to God's perfect, eternal plan.

1 Pet. 1:20; Heb. 9:26-28;

Before the foundation of the world

Eph. 1:4-5; 3:11

2. God sent His Son

Jesus was God - His diety

God sent Jesus from heaven. John 1:1-3, 14; 3:13

3. Born of a woman

Jesus became a man – His humanity.

He was born of woman. He did not have a sin nature. Gen. 3:15; Romans 5:12-14

He was born of a virgin. Luke 1:27, 34, 35; Mat. 1:18, 20, 25

4. Born under the Law

Jesus lived under the Old Testament Covenant/Law, but He never sinned. He was perfect. Heb. 4:15

Jesus had to be the perfect, spotless, unblemished Lamb of God to be the substitute sacrifice for our sin. 2 Cor. 5:21

5. So that he might redeem us

Jesus died in our place. He had to pay for our sins. Eph. 1:7; Rom. 3:24; 1 John 2:2; 1 Pet. 1:18-19 This was clearly stated even by the angel to Joseph: Mat. 1:21

6. Who were under the Law

We are all accountable to the One and only Holy God. We are all sinners and have not measured up to God's holy standard in the Law. Rom. 3:19-20, 23.

7. That we might receive the adoption as sons

According to God's eternal character, our sin separates us from Him, but through faith in Christ we again can be brought back into fellowship with a Holy God to become His children. John 1:12; Rom. 5:1; 8:15, 23
