What we learn about God from Matthew Matthew 1:1-18

- I. God included all kinds of people in the family line of Jesus through Joseph (Matthew 1:1-18).
 - Heroes and villains, moral and immoral (Abraham, David, Judah, Manasseh)
 - Good families and seriously dysfunctional
 - Women (Tamar, Rahab, Ruth, Bathsheba) and men
 - Jew and Gentile
 - The godly who faltered and the evil who repented (Asa, Hezekiah, Manasseh)
- II. God teaches us lessons from Jesus' family line.
 - A. God uses all kinds of people from all kinds of backgrounds.
 - Race, gender, and family history don't matter;
 God looks at the present state of our heart.
 - God uses our unique backgrounds in his plans.
 - B. God's place of priority in our life affects all our descendants.
 - Our choices today become family traits tomorrow.
 - We can either be an example to follow or an example to overcome.
 - C. Jesus came to save all kinds of people.
 - God's grace is available to all.
 - God never condones sin, will probably discipline sin; but never hesitates to forgive sin.
