

Motivated to share the gospel

2 Corinthians 4 & 5

- I. PRIVILEGE – We are motivated to share the gospel as we grasp the privilege of God using us (2 Corinthians 4:5-12).
 - A. The gospel is God’s glorious plan to break through Satan’s darkness (4:5-6).
 - B. We are privileged to share the treasure of the gospel though we are common clay pots (4:7).
 - C. The honor of sharing the gospel compensates us for the price of suffering for the gospel (4:8-12).

- II. MAGNITUDE – We are motivated to share the gospel as we grasp the joy and enormity of eternity (2 Corinthians 4:13-5:13).
 - A. We will be in heaven forever praising God with others (4:13-5:9).
 - B. We will be rewarded by Christ someday for investing in eternal things (5:10-11).

- III. GRACE – We are motivated to share the gospel as we grasp Christ’s love for us (2 Corinthians 5:14-21).
 - A. Christ’s love in dying for us compels us to live for his purposes not ours (5:14-15).
 - B. We represent the grace of God to the world when we share the gospel as His ambassadors (5:16-21).
