Don't worry
Matthew 6:25-34

- I. Don't worry about physical things because God takes care of our needs (Matthew 6:25-30).
 - A. Don't worry about things like money (25-29).
 - We are more important than the birds our heavenly Father feeds (25-26).
 - We can't change our lifespan by worrying (27).
 - We are more important than the flowers God dresses in splendor (28-29).
 - B. Christ promised God would meet our needs even if our faith is small (30).
- II. Don't worry because we are different than unbelievers (Matthew 6:31-32).
 - A. Don't worry like unbelievers who feel desperate and alone (31).
 - B. We have a heavenly Father who knows and cares for us (32).
- III. Main Point: As we seek God's purposes we will see God supply our needs (Matthew 6:33).
 - A. Seek first God's Kingdom and Righteousness
 - God's Kingdom – How I can serve God's spiritual purposes in my situation
 - God's Righteousness – How God wants me to obey him right now
 - B. All these things will be added to you – God will meet our needs in his time as we serve him.
- IV. Don't worry about the future because God wants us to trust him daily (Matthew 6:34).
